Circular

The learned Advocate General has pointed out certain difficulties in respect of issuance of instruction and sanction of fees to AG/ AAGs for the removal of the said difficulties which are being faced by the Law Officers in their functioning the following arrangements are being made with immediate effect:-

1. That the following category of matters shall only be assigned to AG/ AAGs -

- All D.B.matters.
- All matters specified in clause C of order of Law Department dated 26.10.2010.
- Contempt matters in which the Chief Secretary or Principal Secretary has been impleaded as party respondent.

However, this arrangement will not restrict the right of the Administrative Department to assign any other matters to AG/ AAGs.

2. That the Administrative department while making a proposal for appointment of AG/AAGs in a particular case shall specify the category/ slab under which special fee shall be payable and the Administrative department shall clearly mention the category of case and the admissible fees under the circulars/orders issued in this regard , in the its proposal itself.
3. That the Administrative department shall instruct the concerned OIC of the case and make him responsible to ensure that the instructions issued by the Law Department for the appointment of the AG/ AAGs in a particular case is duly obtained from the Law Department and made available to the AG / AAG within one week of engaging the counsel by Administrative department.
4. That the Administrative department shall ensure, that assignment of case should in no case be made contrary to the directions issued by Hon'ble High Court in such matters in which the Court has issued notice or directs the AG or a particular AAG to appear.

It is enjoined that the above mentioned arrangements shall be strictly followed and the Administrative department shall ensure that the above mentioned arrangements have been put into practice with immediate effect so that the cases can be conducted by the Law Officers without any chaos and in a smooth manner.
